

MARION PUBLIC LIBRARY

ITS PURPOSE AND STRUCTURE

The Marion Public Library was established in 1908 and chartered by the State of New York on March 26, 1925.

Its purpose is to provide library materials of all types for the information, recreation and further education of the public it serves. This responsibility is to be carried out by the Library Manager, staff and its Board of Trustees with a friendly attitude and willingness to explain and help in any way possible.

The Board of Trustees is comprised of five community members appointed by the Marion Town Board. It is the duty of the library Board to conduct the business of the library at the policymaking level and determine the fiscal affairs of the library. The administration and management of the library is the responsibility of the Library Manager who is under the direction and review of the Library board.
