

Policy for Unattended Children

It is not the library's function to offer childcare. The library will contact the Wayne County Sheriff's Department if underage children are left unattended in the library without the express permission and understanding of library staff.

All children age 8 or younger shall at all times be attended by a responsible person (e.g. and adult or designated caregiver of responsible age).

Children under age 10 are not permitted to use computers unless a holder of an adult card is sitting with them at all times.

Parents or guardians are responsible for children's behavior in the library. Children deemed out of control or disruptive to other patrons or library staff will be spoken to or asked to leave.

Parents or guardians will be held financially responsible for damage to library property or materials caused by their children.
