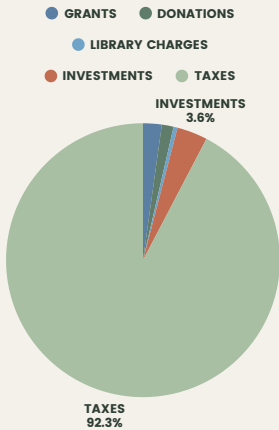
The OWWL Library System serves an area of approximately 2,500 square miles across Ontario, Wayne, Wyoming, and Livingston counties.

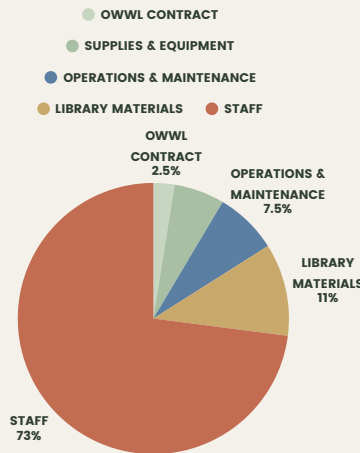
